

WIN £250 to spend on cookery equipment for your school!

Backed by Thanet Earth and Tesco and following on from the great success of last year's competition, Thanet schools are being invited to take part in an exciting recipe competition, designed to raise awareness of healthy ingredients and encourage experimentation in the kitchen. With support from Thanet's finest chefs, a high profile Masterchef-style event at Thanet College will provide the perfect occasion for pupils aged between 5 and 16 to showcase their ideas.



Three categories (KS1, KS2 and KS3&4) can be entered, with each school in Thanet invited to submit up to 4 recipes for consideration. The winner in each category will see their recipe transformed into a recipe card handed out in Tesco Extra, Westwood Cross, with their school receiving a voucher for £250 to spend on cookery equipment. All 12 finalists will receive a beautiful cookbook and a special apron. Event photographs and certificates will be provided for all schools.



Entrants will be shortlisted and judged by a panel of local chefs – including Dev Biswal (The Ambrette), Jason Freedman (The Minnis) and Richard Phillips (celebrity chef from ITV's Lorraine and the Pearsons Arms in Whitstable). Four pupils from each age category will be invited to a fun Masterchef style "cook off" at Thanet College on **Monday 12th March 2012, 3pm-5pm** where the winners will be announced and prizes awarded.

COMPETITION RULES

- 1) The deadline for submission of recipes to Thanet Earth is **Friday 10th February 2012**. All recipes should be sent by email to recipecomp@thanetearth.com, by fax to 01843 844142 or by post to Thanet Earth Marketing, Barrow Man Road, Birchington, Kent, CT7 0AX.
- 2) Each school can submit a **maximum of four** recipes for the competition and should complete the "SCHOOL COMMENTS" section of the template giving details and information about each recipe.
- 3) Recipes should contain at least one of the essential fresh ingredients listed above, can be hot or cold but must take no longer than 30 minutes to prepare. The finalists will be expected to prepare and cook their dish themselves, with assistance provided / allowed only for health and safety purposes.
- 4) Recipes should be creative with limited parental involvement.
- 5) The recipes will be shortlisted on the following criteria: the entrant's effort, imagination, variety of ingredients and appeal.
- 6) Shortlisted schools will be notified by Friday 17th February 2012 and invited to cook their recipes with support from Thanet College on **Monday 12th March, 3pm-5pm**.
